The curriculum for the postgraduate MA builds upon the subjects studied on the BA course and is intended for student graduates of equivalent media study courses. The course of studies deepens the technological and design skills in the audio-visual field and imparts knowledge of media management.

»Media Production« at the University of Applied Sciences »Hochschule-Ostwestfalen-Lippe« is a very application-oriented course of studies which concentrates on electronic media. The main subject areas within the department comprise video, computer graphic, animation and interactive applications.

The range of subject areas covered in the department of Media Production include: design, technology, economics of audio-visual and interactive media.

The master's course of 4 semesters is run with international universities and complies with the ECTS System.

Students are required to choose one major studies subject form.

- Visual production 1 - digital filmproduction
- Visual production 2 - animation, compositing

- Certificate of higher education
- Bachelor or diploma in a practice oriented media studies course
- Certification of english language skills
- Proof of exceptional suitability for the course, e.g. work portfolio

#### **Graduation**

On successful completion of all exams, the internationally recognised qualification »Master of Arts« will be attained. The course conforms to the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). The department supports international student exchanges between EU and also non-EU countries.

The department cooperates with the conservatory of music in Detmold, international universities and also successfully with commercial partners from the broadest realms of the media.
